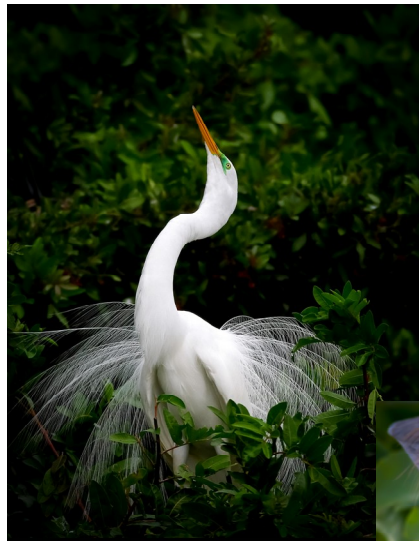

Storter Traveling Exhibit is Awarded Grant

The Storter Committee of the Friends of the Museum of the Everglades applied for a United Arts Council Community Arts Fund grant to cover the cost of matting and framing selected pieces of the Rob Storter Collection. These items will be used for a traveling exhibit. Former Museum of the Everglades Manager Donna Shelley has been hired as a consultant to organize the Traveling Exhibit. She will be working together with Jennifer Guida, Curator of the Collier County Museums, in selecting the theme and appropriate items for this new exhibit.

Historical Sites of Collier County

The Collier County Historic and Archaeological Preservation Board (HAPB) completed its brochure listing historic sites throughout the County. Sites are grouped according to location: Naples, Marco Island, Everglades City, Chokoloskee, Copeland, and Immokalee. The mission of the HAPB is to increase public awareness of the importance and significance of Collier County's historical and archaeological heritage by protecting, preserving and perpetuating Collier County's historical and archaeological artifacts, sites, districts, structures, buildings and properties.
