Storter Collection at Marco Island Historical Museum

Selected prints from the Rob Storter Collection are now on display at the Marco Island Historical Museum. The Storter family is well known as one of the early pioneers in southwest Florida. George W. Storter and his sons settled in the town of Everglade in the late 1800s, purchasing William Allen's home (now the famous Rod & Gun Club). Rob Storter's memories of his life and times in the old Everglades are depicted in this one-of-a-kind collection of art and drawings. A time forgotten but preserved by a

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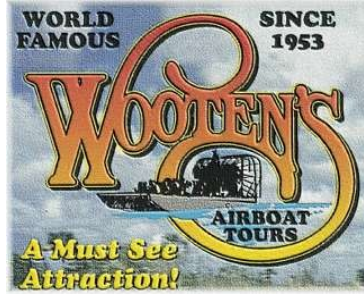
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
