Pauline Reeves Gallery



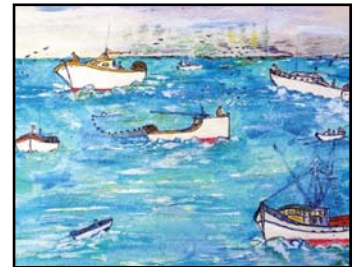

Rob Storter Exhibit


