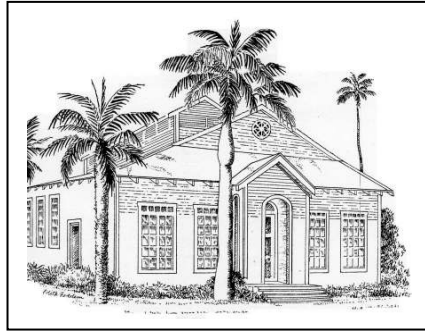

Historic Buildings around Everglades City: Walking Tours

Everglades City, the County Seat from 1923 to 1962, was developed by the flamboyant entrepreneur Barron Gift Collier. It was his Company Town and the headquarters for the heroic effort needed to complete the Tamiami Trail from Naples to the Dade County border.

This publication describes some of the city's historic buildings and old Florida houses built in Collier's time and before, including:

- *famous Rod & Gun Lodge, visited by U.S. Presidents and international celebrities*
- *Bank of Everglades building, where tea can be drunk in the vault*
- *Museum of the Everglades, the former commercial Laundry*
- *City Hall, once the Collier County Court House*
- *Seafood Depot, which welcomed railroad passengers until 1959*
- *Ivey House, was the recreation hall for Trail workers*

It also visits places further a field, such as the *Smallwood Store and Museum* in Chokoloskee and the *smallest Post Office in the USA* at Ochopee.

The book has 44 pages, packed with descriptions and pictures of over 50 buildings plus maps, old photographs and historical background. It is worth much more than the \$8.00 being charged by the Friends, who wrote and published it as part of their ongoing effort to preserve local history.
